



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN**

**ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHER
TRAINING PROGRAM (ELTT) PROJECT**

AND

**SEKOLAH TINGGI ILMU EKONOMI
SYARIAH NAHDLATUL ULAMA
(STIESNU) BENGKULU INDONESIA**

1. Parties

The Parties to this Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) are **English Language Teacher Training (ELTT) Program** as part of World Learning Inc., a 501 (c) (3) US non-profit organization registered with the US Agency for International Development (USAID), having its International Development Offices at 1015 15th Street, NW, 7th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20005, USA, full funded by Regional English Language Office (RELO) US Embassy-Jakarta; and **Sekolah Tinggi Ilmu Ekonomi Syariah Nahdlatul Ulama (STIESNU) Bengkulu**, a private and formal educational institution under Ministry of Religious Affairs Bengkulu Indonesia having its Office at Jl. Pancur mas Kelurahan Sukarami Kecamatan Selebar, Bengkulu Indonesia known as the “Parties.”

2. Purpose

The Parties have discussed mutual interest **in the English Language Teacher Training (ELTT)**. The Parties recognize that this MOU is broadly drafted, but that it will form the basis of a proposed plan of action. The MOU underscores the commitment of both RELO US Embassy Jakarta (Together with World Learning US) and STIESNU Bengkulu to work jointly to do some program related to **education, research and community services**.

3. Communications

All communications relating to this MOU shall be directed only to the specific persons designated to represent US Embassy Jakarta (Together with World Learning US) and STIESNU Bengkulu on this activity.

4. Final Agreement

It is the intention of the Parties to enter into a Final Agreement once the issues outlined in Section 3 have been researched and agreed upon. In the final Agreement, the Parties will specify in greater detail the proposed partnership arrangements, including co-branding of the curriculum and materials, financial contributions and obligations, intellectual property, teacher certification, and methods of course delivery.

5. Duration

This MOU is effective as of the day signed by the Parties and shall continue for three year from the date of the signing. Upon written assent, the Parties may extend this MOU for additional periods.

6. Confidentiality and Proprietary Information

In developing the proposed certificate program, it will be necessary for the Parties to disclose information that is proprietary in nature. Therefore, each party agrees that all information provided to the other Party shall be treated as confidential and the property of the disclosing Party, unless the disclosing Party has identified the information as being non-confidential, and shall be used solely for the purpose for which it is provided. Each party agrees that it will use the same reasonable efforts to protect the other’s proprietary information as it uses to protect its own proprietary information now and in the future regardless of the outcome of this MOU. Disclosures of such information shall be restricted to those who are directly participating in the proposal development efforts identified in this MOU.

7. Obligations

The only lasting obligation created by this MOU is to maintain the confidentiality of information as specified above and to create an exclusive relationship between the Parties for the purposes detailed above. Each Party to this MOU is free to withdraw without financial liability or obligation to the other unless an obligation has been created, accepted, and signed through a final Agreement, and respecting the commitment to exclusivity with the other Party.
